How to write a Parable

- 1. Start with the moral lesson. Think about a moral principle that has been important in your own life, or one that you're still struggling to learn fully. ...
- 2. Consider its consequences. What might happen as a result of behaving (or not behaving) according to your moral lesson? ...
- 3. Write a beginning, middle, and end.

Tips:

1. The Jews were the more powerful people - who would that be today?

2. The Samaritans were hated - who would that be today?

3. The priests were the most respected people at that time - who would that be today?

- 5. Where would the injured person be taken today?
- 6. How would the Samaritan travel today?
