

Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to let you know the uniform changes that will come into effect from September 2025.

We are mindful of the cost of uniforms and so we have made every effort to reduce the amount of branding, which tends to add cost to individual items. These changes were made after careful consideration and following consultation with the students.

The uniform from September will consist of the following:

- Black Immanuel Blazer with embroidered logo or, alternatively, a badge can be purchased to be sewn onto a blazer pocket
- Black Tailored trousers (logo not compulsory), straight leg or boot cut
- V neck sweatshirt (logo not compulsory)
- Colour assigned for year 7 and will be taken through all year groups.
- Colours for September 2025 are as follows:
  - Year 7 – Grey
  - Year 8 – Navy
  - Year 9 - Maroon
  - Year 10- Green
  - Year 11- Black
- Polo shirts for summer (logo not compulsory). Colours are the same as those above for sweatshirts.
- Immanuel School Tie (all ties will be blue, although any existing ties can be used)

PE uniform has also been changed again following feedback from students. This will better serve our students in terms of comfort, durability, functionality and inclusivity. Students are required to have one item from each of the below columns.
