We believe that high standards of uniform help to establish the tone of life at Immanuel College and provide a clear identity enabling students to identify with their school. Students should wear their school uniform with pride, remembering to be smart on all occasions.

In 2022 the sweater for Year 7 will be bottle green. This colour is kept throughout Key Stage 3.

Standard uniform for Years 7, 8,9,10 & 11:

- Black blazer with Immanuel College logo*
- Plain v-neck sweatshirt in year-group colour with or without Immanuel College logo*
- Immanuel College tie* in house colour
- Plain formal white shirt with stiff collar and top button (NOT polo shirt) to be fastened at all times
- Approved logo trousers only* (straight or boot cut) no stretchy fabric.
- School bag big enough/suitable to carry planner, stationery and up to 6 x A4 exercise books
- Plain black shoes.



Clothing required for religious purposes is permitted to be worn as appropriate.

No false eyelashes or long/false nails are permitted at any time.

A watch (but not a smart watch or Apple watch) and one small pair of stud earrings are the only permitted items of jewellery that can be worn in school.

Smart watches, Apple watches and all other WiFi enabled devices must be switched off and kept in school bags at all times.

Unbranded clothing is available to purchase from the school shop.



*All uniform items that include the Immanuel logo are available from our recommended uniform school suppliers Whittakers Schoolwear in Shipley or Farsley.

We have found that setting high expectations leads to success and this has been demonstrated by our increasingly improving exam results. We also operate a uniform 'swap shop' where all items of the school uniform can be donated or exchanged.

Part of those expectations is that students will wear our uniform with pride and take responsibility for ensuring that every part of their uniform complies with the rules. This includes the trousers. There are a selection of uniform logo trousers, available from Whittakers Schoolwear, as well as in our swap shop.

We trust that you will join us in setting these expectations for your son or daughter so that they set their sights high and achieve their best.

Jewellery, Hair and Make-Up

Students are not permitted to wear any jewellery except a watch (not a smart watch) and one small pair of plain gold or silver stud earrings worn in the earlobes. We do not allow long or false nails or eye lashes, rings, bracelets or additional piercings.

Hairstyles should be conventional; we do not allow "fashion" or extreme hair styles or colours (e.g. shaved patterns/tramlines/mohawks or hairstyles where there are significant differences between hair lengths/colours within the haircut). Hair should be a natural colour. Shaved areas must be grade 3 or above.

No make-up should be worn in Y7 or Y8. Any make-up worn in Y9-11 must be discrete.

If a student attends school inappropriately dressed they may be asked to exchange non-uniform clothing or footwear for clean items supplied by the school or removed from class.

Watches and valuables

Watches/valuables should be handed in at the start of each lesson and will be kept safe whilst in PE.

Football boots

Football boots are very important as many PE lessons will take place on the field which can sometimes be slippery especially during or after wet weather.

Reasonably priced football boots can be purchased online or from most sports shops, expensive football boots do not need to be purchased.



Key Stage 4 (Years 10 & 11)

The year group colours change for Years 10 and 11, alternating between grey and black (with the same colour being kept throughout Key Stage 4). When entering Key Stage 4 students replace their Key Stage 3 year group colour items with similar grey or black items (depending on the colour for that year). The PE kit remains the same.
