## The story of Pentecost

Pentecost is a Jewish festival celebrating when the people received a gift from God - His Law. Jesus' disciples were in Jerusalem for this big festival, where they were about to receive another gift.....

### Acts 2: 1-4

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together when suddenly a sound came from the sky like a violent wind, and tongues of fire appeared that separated and came to rest on each of them.



They were all filled with the Holy Ghost and began to speak in different languages.
